Love-Lift Update

Since April 2021, each month we have filled on average 326 Love-Lift bags to serve eleven different areas of need in Mexico, Guatemala, and Indians in South Dakota, USA. A total of 2,300 bags have been delivered in the last seven months of this year. We give glory to God for each chance to serve those in need.

Outreach in Baja, Mexico September 2021

Love-Lift Ministries was blessed to partner with Dr Alfredo of San Diego to go down to two towns (Camalu and Colonet) in Baja, Mexico, about 280 miles south of our warehouse in Santa Ana, CA. About 40 people from the USA and Mexico, including doctors and a dentist went down for a three day outreach. Three different communities were touch by the love of Jesus through the Word of God and practical ways.



Vehicles and trailers carried all the team and food, clothing, shoes, 450 Love-Lift bags and 12 layettes to Baja.

Colonet is probably the biggest of the three communities. Approx. 150 people attended, and about 35-40 gave their hearts to Jesus. The team prayed for many sick people. Many young girls received blessings in their LLM bags.

A community of 700-800 people, South Camalu is a very poor area. Most people work in agriculture. Due to lack of rain, very few jobs are available. About 300 people came to the outreach. Approx. 200 people gave their hearts to the Lord. We prayed for people and many were crying. We could not rent chairs, thus the people had to stand for 3 hours. That was a miracle.
