After 38 years, we have completed another year full of a variety of ministry opportunities for 7,000 people in 2014 with our Love-Lift bags. Many of you have been a wonderful part of this great challenge to meet the ever pressing needs of God's people in less fortunate places abroad and here in the US. Since 2003 alone, 88,525 Love-Lift bags have been distributed where God has opened doors of service and the ministry of compassion and hope to God's hurting people.





Bibles (English & Spanish) and the colorful illustrated Gospel booklets for children (English & Spanish) are another important part of donations given to the churches and ministries we help. Many pastors in these desperately poor communities do not have extra funds to purchase many needed resources for their own areas. Our program is a great encouragement to those serving in small struggling churches. Love-Lift bags bring hope and blessings in tangible ways to show that others care with God's love.

God's message of hope and caring comes also in our newborn baby layette program continuing since 1982. For 33 years, several thousand baby layettes have provided essential and necessary items to help mothers in need without provisions for their new infant. The Sisters of Sewing ministry makes bibs, burp cloths, booties, and cloth diapers and baby quilts year round to supply the many needs for these precious babies. Several other individuals and women's ministry groups participate also. Let us continue to provide God's hope and sustaining strength to families in difficult circumstances to trust God in their times of need.



Women sewing at home and in women's groups prepare dolls, hats, pillows, quilts, stuffed toys and much more. Without their loving efforts we would not have special gifts to give. Our warehouse team is very faithful twice a week to minister in filling our many bags. These people are preparing God's hope in loving service to help build up the Body of Christ.
